

What can I recycle through the new single-stream system?

- Paper (newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, envelopes)
- Phone books
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper bags
- Corrugated cardboard
- Office and school papers
- Empty glass jars and bottles
- Aluminum cans and clean foil
- Empty tin and steel cans - food debris removed
- Fiber board - cereal boxes, shoe boxes
- All plastic containers labeled #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 (milk, water, detergent, shampoo, bleach bottles, etc - lids and food debris removed)

BE GREEN -
ALL CONTAINERS SHOULD BE
EMPTY AND CLEAN

What is NOT recyclable in this system?

- No garbage
- No plastic bags of any kind
- No food waste
- No food tainted items (used paper plates or boxes, paper towels or paper napkins)
- No motor oil bottles
- No hazardous chemical containers
- No plastic toys or sporting goods
- No electronics or batteries
- No Styrofoam of any kind
- No ice cream cartons, wax coated paper
- No light bulbs of any kind
- No wire coat hangers
- No yard waste or wood
- No unnumbered plastics
- No pots and pans, toasters, appliances
- No pizza boxes
- No aerosol cans
- No mirrors or window glass
